Cleveleys Coastal Defence Improvement and Promenade Enhancement Scheme

MORE of the new look seafront at Cleveleys is soon to be revealed.

The North Promenade has been rebuilt to provide modern-day flood protection and to create a 21st century seafront for the public.

The purpose of this leaflet is to update you on the exciting developments on Cleveleys seafront



The first phase of the £20 million project

Between Carr Gate and Beach Road - was opened in March and has won a number of awards for innovative design and quality of construction including a nomination for the Prime Minister's Better Building Awards and a highly commended in the British Construction Industry Awards.



The next phase of the works which runs from Beach Road to Victoria Road West is starting to be revealed. We hope to have all of this area open in the New Year.

Where the promenade meets the sea in this section, the profile has been broken up by creating a number of curved build outs which has also created a number of bays for safe play on the beach.



At the junction with Victoria Road West, there is a large recreational area recalling the days when this part of Cleveleys was known as The Arena and formed a venue for open air entertainment. The new Sea Terrace will also provide seating and picnic areas. Plans to establish an outdoor Childrens' ride area are also well in hand.



Opposite the Jubilee Gardens, a new boat shaped building is under construction. It will house a café, public toilets, a tourist information centre and a base for the Lifeguard service. Close by there will be an interactive water feature where children can play and some open air showers to wash off the sand and saltwater.

A complete transformation of the whole North Promenade area has been created by Wyre Borough Council working in a very successful partnership with contractors Birse Coastal.
