

# Works Completed during the last week.

**Week 129: Monday 12 May to Friday 16 May 2008**

- Piling work on Phase 4 of the Cleveleys sea defence and promenade improvement works continued this week along the toe of the proposed revetment. The piles will be driven to a depth of 4.5 metres below the beach and will serve to act as a front restraint to the new defences and also prevent tidal action undermining the new structure.
- The precast concrete units that will make up the bulk of the new works continue at the Thornton precast yard. Precasting offsite provides the conditions and control that allow a quality to be produced that would otherwise be difficult to achieve in situ given the severe coastal environment.

- Work continued on the water feature adjacent to the cafe this week with the resin bound blue glass design being completed and the equipment that provides the water jets and lighting being installed.
