

# Works Completed during the last week.

**Week 184: Monday 1 June to Friday 5 June 2009**

- Work continued carrying out the trench and ducting works for the United Utilities electric cable diversion for the full length of the works. Apart from the section outside of the works which will be carried out when United Utilities commence the diversion, this work was completed this week.
- Concrete and demolished material continued to be placed into the abandoned sea outfall chambers this week at the southern end of the works.

- The highway drainage along this stretch of promenade drains via two drains located across the promenade. Recent CCTV camera surveys revealed that these drains were in a such a poor condition that they require replacing. Work commenced and continued throughout the week on the replacement of the drain located centrally along the works. This is carried out using open cut supported trench techniques.
