

Works Completed during the last week.

Week 208: Monday 16th November to Friday 20th November 2009

- High spring tides and appalling weather restricted progress on a number of activities this week particularly the in situ concrete pavement slab. However, some progress was made and this week saw the completion of the revetment with the last 3 precast revetment units being placed.
- On the promenade, the final length of existing sea wall was demolished up to the completed phase 3 works.

- The third and final storm gate frame was positioned to line and level within the opening left within the rear walls opposite Coronation Road.
- The in situ reinforced concrete slab was placed to the precast sea wall units installed last week and also to the final storm gate frame placed earlier this week.
- The walls which define the split level promenade continued on both waves 5 and 4. All the upper units to wave 5 were placed completing this wave and the lower row of units to wave 4 were placed.
- Filling and compaction of imported and recycled material to formation level continued to the upper promenade areas where the intermediate walls have been complete incorporating the installation of any required chambers and manholes.
- Representatives from Wyre Borough Council and Birse Coastal attended the national Constructing Excellence awards at Lords cricket ground this week where the scheme was awarded the prestigious top prize of Project of the Year. The award went to the project team 'that has shown the highest level of technical achievement, innovation and application of best practice, while delivering a project to time and budget and with team working throughout the supply chain'.
